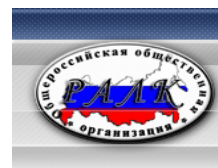

We are pleased to invite you to the VIIIth International Cognitive Linguistics Congress “**Cognitio and Communicatio in Today’s Globalised World**” to be held from **10 to 12 October 2018** at the Higher School of Translation and Interpreting, Lomonosov Moscow State University, Russia.

Being a key arena for experts in the field, the International Cognitive Linguistics Congress has been held annually by the Russian Cognitive Linguists Association (www.ralk.info) since 2003. In 2018 the Congress is hosted by the Higher School of Translation and Interpreting (www.esti.msu.ru) at Lomonosov Moscow State University.

An exciting programme has been put together to encompass a wide range of topics:

- Knowledge representation structures in socio-cultural transfer and translation
- Corpus linguistics and cognitive pragmatics
- Cognitive Terminology and professional communication
- Cognitive basis of translation and interpreting
- Translation and society: knowledge and understanding
- The anthropocentric paradigm in translation theory: interaction between languages and cultures

Please be certain that the length of your presentation remains within the allocated time: plenary talks – 40 minutes, paper sessions – 20 minutes (including questions from the audience), workshops – 50 minutes.

Congress fee: €100

GUIDELINES FOR FORMATTING PAPER PROPOSALS

- **No more than 4 pages** in Microsoft Word, version 1997 – 2003
- Times New Roman, 14 pt
- Line spacing: 1
- Text is justified at both margins
- All margins: 2 cm
- Indention: 1 cm
- No intervals between paragraphs
- No double spaces in the text
- Aligned to the right, in ***bold italics***, come the initials and the last name(s) of the author(s)
- After the name, in brackets come *the city and country* in italics, below – *affiliation*, and – *email address*.
- Centred in bold, comes the title of the paper in **CAPITAL** letters
- Followed by an Abstract (4-5 lines) and Key words (5-7 words).
